Dear parent/carer,


As per my previous letter, dated 10th May 2024, I am writing to inform you of Y11 students' last day in the academy. The final full cohort exam of the 2024 exam season is on Friday 14th June 2024. However, there are still some smaller cohort exams (Music, Further Maths and Hospitality and Catering) week commencing 17th June 2024. During period 1 on Monday 17th June, we will be hosting our Class of 2024 Leavers Assembly. Students will be invited in to say their farewells to staff and their Y11 peers and have their shirts signed. Students are not expected to be in uniform on this day, but should bring a school shirt to have it signed by their friends and staff if they wish. At the end of the assembly students will leave the site and only those studying Music, Further Maths and Hospitality and Catering will be required to access the academy, as per the masterclass timetable (previously shared) and for the examinations. As with Prom, access to the Class of 2024 Leavers Assembly is a privilege and not a right and unfortunately, some students are unable to attend. These students and parents/carers have been informed.

Students should arrive on site via the normal **student entrance at 8:55am**, where they will be **greeted by staff and directed to the lecture theatre** for the final time as Outwood Academy Carlton students. Following the assembly we have **arranged for drinks and snacks in the gym** where students can have their **shirts signed and say their farewells to staff** before they leave. Students will leave the site via the gym between 10:15am -10:30am. We would ask that you encourage your son/daughter to journey home safely, respectfully and responsibly.

I wanted to take this opportunity to thank you for your unwavering support during your son/daughter's final year in compulsory education. I am proud of the effort and commitment that students have shown in their exams and I am hopeful that they will get the results they deserve and wish for in August.

Finally, I look forward to seeing parents of students who are eligible for the Prom breakfast on 28th June (start time to follow).
