Our Mental Health and Well being Champions have been working hard this half term for Mental Health Awareness Week.

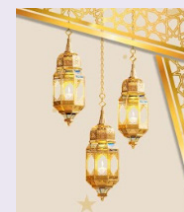


We all took part in 'Wear it Green Day' on Friday 15th May to show awareness for the Mental Health Foundation

We are excited to share the date of our Eid Fair. **Tuesday 3rd June, 3:30pm** on the school playground.



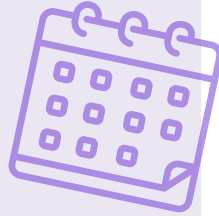
