You can choose what you want to do for your topic homework and how you want to present it, but here are some suggestions to get you started. Can you link your homework to another area of the curriculum?

- **Maths**- Compare the weights of objects in your house and make a more or less chart.
- **English**- Write a recount of something you have done at the weekend.
- **Science** – Create a science poster based on our Magna trip.
- **Art**- Use media other than paint or pencils to create a piece of artwork, such as collage with paper or fabric.
- **DT**- With an adult, create/sew your own items using fabric from old clothes to make a new item.
- **Geography**- Compare your own local are to an area you have visited and present the similarities and differences.
- **History**- Using junk modelling materials, create your own spear inspired by the stone age.
- **MFL**- Draw a picture of your family and label who is in it in French.
- **Music**- Write and preform a song based on 5 things that make you happy. This could be a rap, a rhyme or a pop song!
- **PE**- Create your own gymnastic routine. You could even invent your own poses and name them!

Remember, you can choose what you want to do for your project and you aren't limited to just one idea. I'm looking forward to seeing your ideas and what you come up with!
