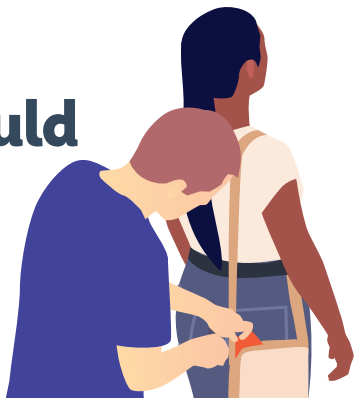




Robbery and Theft from a Person

Robbery and Theft from a Person -

Key Facts:

- Look confident and be aware of your surroundings as much as possible.
- Keep your phone hidden when in public, especially if you are unfamiliar with the area.
- Cover up expensive jewellery and don't advertise what you have on social media.
- Don't leave items such as phones and purses or wallets on tables in public places, especially outdoors. It can be easy for someone to quickly snatch them.
- Security mark valuable items with a UV marker or security sticker, so there's more chance of them being returned to you if someone finds them.
- When out walking try to keep your bag or phone nearest a building line.
