New Timetable

On Monday the 28th June we are rolling the timetable forward. This means that students will start next academic year's timetable now. This will enable students in Y11, who are coming back to our Sixth Form to start their studies 4 weeks early. Given the impact of Covid 19 on the amount of missed learning Y11 students have had, we felt this was the right thing to do. Other year groups will also benefit as it will give them extended time for their new qualifications and curriculum subjects.

The Covid 19 risk assessment on the 28th June will be amended in line with the new timetable.

A new one-way system will be implemented allowing teachers to stay in classrooms and students to move between teaching blocks. This will ensure time is maximised for every lesson. The new risk assessment will be uploaded to the website. Key details will be explained to students in an assembly on Monday 28th June.
