Medical evidence required to authorise all absences due to medical appointments

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following an update to our Academy Attendance Policy and Procedures I am writing to make you aware that moving forward **if your child has a medical appointment, for us to authorise this absence we will need to see evidence of the appointment.** This evidence can be dropped off or presented to reception, preferably prior to the appointment itself. In order for absences to be authorised the following evidence will be accepted:

- Medical appointment card confirming attendance
- Medical appointment letter
- Text message evidence of appointment
- Copy of prescription showing name and date
- Prescribed medication with pharmacist label showing name and date
- Hospital discharge letter

Failure to provide this evidence will mean that the absence is unauthorised. Where possible please try to arrange medical appointments outside of the school day.
