Y10 Geography Fieldwork - Hornsea

As part of your child's geography GCSE course, they are required to carry out a physical and a human geography fieldwork day. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to develop their fieldwork skills and to be able to apply our classroom learning to the wider world.

Year 10 geography students will be taking part in the physical geography fieldwork day on **Friday 24th April 2026** at Hornsea beach. Students will be travelling by coach to the coast, to investigate the sea defences, where they will be accompanied by their class teacher, to collect data which will then be analysed in the classroom and examined in their paper 3 exam in June 2027. This is a compulsory part of the Geography GCSE and therefore there is no cost to students.

Students need to arrive at the academy at their normal time for 8:20am. Students will be required to wear their school PE kit and appropriate footwear as we will be walking on the beach. Students will arrive back at the academy in time for the normal finish of 2:45pm.

Please note that students are required to bring a packed lunch. Should your child receive free school meals, then a packed lunch will be provided. There may be an opportunity to purchase lunch at the beach but this is not to be relied upon.
