Below are details of what will be happening during this week. We would appreciate parents encouraging students to get involved in these activities.

All week - 'ReadforGood' readathon

Students and staff will be encouraged to get sponsored to set a reading goal and read as much as they can from **Monday 8th to Sunday 14th of July**.

- Sponsor cards and bookmarks can be collected from the library prior to the readathon
- Parents can donate as little or as much as they would like to 'ReadforGood', a charity providing books and stories to children in need
