With the May half-term approaching, your year group has been identified as one that **may be involved in antisocial behaviour (ASB)** within **Kirkby-in-Ashfield**. Neighbourhood Policing Teams (NPT) are aware that this behaviour involves **only a small number of individuals**, and those responsible will be dealt with appropriately. Antisocial behaviour (ASB) is defined under the **Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014** as conduct that causes, or is likely to cause, **harassment, alarm, or distress** to others.

If you are seen in **Kirkby-in-Ashfield** engaging in antisocial behaviour, the following actions may be taken:

- **Police may require your name and address** under **Section 50 of the Police Reform Act 2002**.  
Failure to provide details, or providing false information, may result in arrest.
- **Officers may take you home** and speak with your **parents or guardians** about your behaviour in and around Kirkby-in-Ashfield.
- A **Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO)** is enforced.  
This is a direction to leave a specified area. If issued, you must leave the following locations for the period stated:
  - Kingsway Park
  - Kingsway
  - Hodgkinson Road
  - Station Road
  - Kirkby High Street
  - Kirkby Plaza

Returning to these areas within the time specified may result in a **Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN)**.

- If antisocial behaviour continues, a **Community Protection Warning (CPW)** may be issued by the police and Ashfield District Council and recorded on police systems.
- Failure to comply with a CPW may result in a **Community Protection Notice (CPN)**, which can lead to **fines or further enforcement action**.

Parents and guardians will be informed of all incidents and **may be held responsible** for the actions of their children.

If you live in an Ashfield Council property, both you and your parents can be issued with tenancy warnings due to your behaviour. Failure to comply with these warnings may result in eviction from your home.
