We always encourage our students to contribute actively in shaping the educational experience they and their fellow students receive. Any student in any classroom in any year, has a voice that should be heard and our Student Voice programme facilitates this in our academy. Student Voice sits at the heart of our academy.

Throughout the first week of this half term I shared with our students through an assembly how proud I am of the way that they support each other and we celebrated together the broad and balanced curriculum which offers such rich educational experiences and opportunities. 82% of our Y11 students completed their Maths holiday packs before the deadline. This once again demonstrates their commitment and determination to succeed.
