

Year 6 Parent Information

Please see a summary of the information that was provided at the parent information session in school:

SATs

In Year 6, pupils will sit their statutory KS2 assessments (SATs). We will be supporting the children in a number of ways which will include: celebrating successes and improvements throughout the year; Year 6 reward points; half termly tests; regular analysis of children's work to meet their needs; reinforcement of key skills; revision packs and personalised support and intervention when required.

Year 6 Rewards:

Pupils will have a range of opportunities to earn Dojo reward points. These points are awarded for going the extra mile and are in addition to school super swirls. Children will be able to exchange these reward points for a variety of different prizes over the course of the year.

Points can be earned for: participation in additional learning sessions such as Y6 breakfast club, after school club and interventions; improving test scores and completing homework activities.

Year 6 Breakfast Revision Club

Year 6 children can enter their classrooms between 8.15 and 8.25 to participate in additional learning and revision sessions. Breakfast will be provided free of charge for children arriving at this time and Dojo reward points will also be given for attendance.

Learning Packs:

After half term, all year 6 children will be provided with a homework / revision pack. Teachers will direct your child which pages to complete and when. This will ensure that homework and revision relates to what they have been learning in lessons.

Helping Your Child at Home:

You can help your child at home by supporting them in accessing their homework activities; ensuring attendance in school, encouraging them to read daily, encouraging them to attend Year 6 breakfast club or any set after school clubs.
