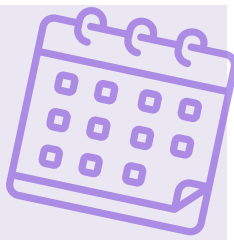

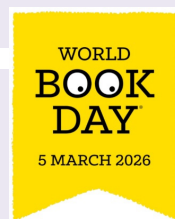

Children are invited to dress as their favourite book character. There will be a book swap and a story potato competition.

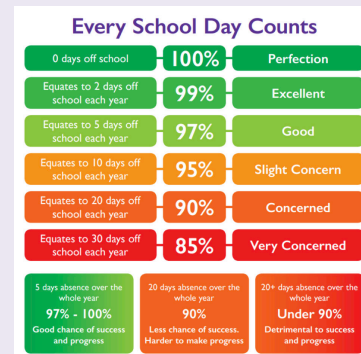
An author, John Rowe will be visiting school and his book will be available to buy.

Missing even a few days can lead to gaps in knowledge and make it harder for pupils to keep up.

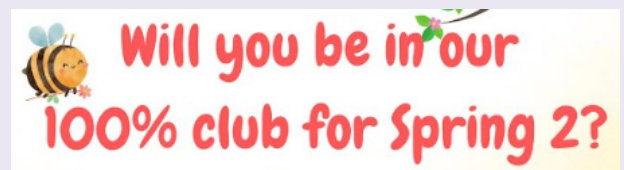
Our attendance target is 97% and we are committed to achieving this, with your support.
