I am delighted to invite your child to our exciting provision during the summer holidays. The provision is only available for a small number of students including your child and will be an ideal opportunity for them to spend time with their peers, build confidence and engage in activities. This provision is free of charge including healthy snacks and lunch, additional spending money may be required for trips out of the academy but this will be communicated to parents/carers in advance.

Students must arrive at the academy for a 9.30am prompt and will leave at 2.30pm. Depending on the uptake this will determine what activities, trips or events go ahead. Students will be responsible for arranging suitable travel to and from the academy following their day at school. Students should arrive at school unless stated otherwise and therefore students are expected to meet straight at the venue. (See attached the timetable of activities, subject to change)

Register an interest and a text will be sent before the end of term confirming your child's place. Students are welcome to bring with them a packed lunch or money to purchase food and drink from school. The academy reserves the right to withdraw the trip at any stage.

Students are not required to wear academy uniform but expected to dress appropriately for the day's activities. Those who require medication should bring this with them. Medication, with the exception of inhalers and epipens, should be given to the member of staff leading the day to safely store. We will require a completed parental medication administration form before accepting any medication.

During the course of the provision photographs may be taken. These may be used by the academy and/or Outwood Grange Academies Trust for publicity purposes in the future, including on social media.
